

Regulations of the Show

The show will be held in Fontvieille (France) **on may 6 and 7, 2023**

DOGS ENTRANCE

- Until 8 AM.
- Beginning of evaluations 10 AM. on Saturday, 9 AM. on sunday

PRESENTATION

It is specified that the dog can only be presented by a single person, which excludes any "double Handling". It is prohibited by any other person to call or to excite the dog outside the ring with any object, whistle or another gesture. The judge is responsible for enforcing this rule either by ring commissioner or by the organizers of the exhibition.

He may, in the event of non-compliance, disqualify the dog and record the reason in his judge's notebook. A certain tolerance may however be accepted by the judge, the only master in his ring.

CLASS DIVISION

MINOR PUPPY class (BABY) - from 3 to 6 months (with valid rabies vaccination for travel and by country conditions)

PUPPY class - from 6 to 9 months

JUNIOR class (YOUNG) - from 9 to 18 months

INTERMEDIATE class - from 15 to 24 months

OPEN class - from 15 months and over

WORKING class - from 15 months and over (only with FCI working certificate). To enter a dog in working class, the entry form must be accompanied by a copy of the FCI compulsory certificate, WCC (Working Class Certificate). The certificate must be obtained before the closing date of the exhibition.

CHAMPION class - Only boxers who have won a national or international title based on several claims (for example: International Champion, National Champions of the respective FCI countries) can be entered in the Champion Class. Must provide a copy of the certificate, in its absence, the dog will be registered automatically in open class. The certificate must be obtained before the closing date of the exhibition.

VETERAN class - from 8 years and over.

Exhibitors must be able to justify the day of the exhibition of their dog's career by presenting, if the organizing committee so requests, the working book and the original documents concerning their dog's career.

Progeny group - Composed of the reproductive present and at least 5 products all present in individual class. Products from at least 3 litters with at least 2 females, for the males. 2 litter products minimum for females.

Breeding group - Composed of 3 subjects, at least, of the same color already engaged in individual class whatever it is and from the same breeding.

Entries for these last 2 classes can be taken on the spot before the start of the honor ring.

White Boxers

Will be judged in a single class, age and sex confused, without detailed judgment, without qualifier, nor ranking, by all the judges, at the start of the ring of honor. Only the best will be rewarded.

ENTRY FEES

They must be paid at the same time as the commitment (on <https://cedia.fr>)

By registering for a WUBOX exhibition, the exhibitor undertakes to:

- respect the rules of the WUBOX exhibition,
 - have his dogs' microchips checked for functionality.
- The commitment will remain with the organizing company itself if the dog cannot be presented.

REFUSAL OR EXCLUSIONS

a) commitments: the organization reserves the right to refuse all commitments that she thinks she shouldn't admit and repay them even after having accepted.

b) dogs: On their entry the dogs will be examined by the service veterinarian and may be refused: dogs appearing ill, dogs with a cold, dogs with skin disease, dogs that are blind or cripples, dangerous dogs, monorchid dogs, cryptorchids or atrophies (these cannot be judged).

The decision of the veterinary service is final. In these different cases, commitments will not be refunded. Dogs not listed in the catalog cannot be judged, unless their inclusion in the catalog has been omitted by the committee of organization (proof of commitment will be requested).

JUDGEMENTS

The judge's decision is final. An objection against it is inadmissible. Any undue criticism of a judge decision will result in the loss of all awarded ratings, titles and prizes, as well as immediate expulsion from the show.

Exclusion from all later events can also be imposed by the WUBOX Board (proposal to the WUBOX Board by the show management).

In no case, a dog absent at the timing of the judgments will only be considered later. First, all dogs will be judged and qualified. The 4 best of each class (unspecified of the classification) will be selected for the ring of honor of the afternoon.

The qualifiers awarded will be:

For the minor and puppy classes: Very Promising, Promising or Fairly Promising.

For all other classes: Excellent, Very Good, Good, Sufficient or Disqualified or cannot be judged.

HONOR RING

From 2.30 PM. (or later at the end of all judgments). In the main ring, the members of the jury will examine the white boxers, breeding groups and progeny groups.

The responsible of the pre-ring of honor will verify systematically the identification number or the tattoo of boxers qualified for the ring of honor.

Class by class the selected subjects will be called in the honor ring to be ranked and receive their rewards.

Then Best Puppy Female.

And then WUBOX Puppy Winner.

Ranking of junior classes with the **WUBOX Youth Winner**

FM, BM, FF, BF.

Then WUBOX Best Junior Male and WUBOX Best Junior Female

And then BIS WUBOX BEST JUNIOR (go to ring of Honour on Sunday)

The title of WUBOX Youth Winner is awarded on the occasion of the WUBOX show to one male and one female each of the fawn and brindle color, which were rated "Excellent 1" in the junior class.

Classification of breeding groups, progeny groups and designation of the best white.

Ranking of working classes with the **WUBOX Working**

Winner FM, BM, FF, BF.

The title of WUBOX Working winner is awarded on the occasion of the WUBOX show to one male and one female of each of the fawn and brindle color from the working class.

Ranking of veteran classes with the **WUBOX Veteran**

Winner FM, BM, FF, BF.

Then Best Veteran Male and Best Veteran Female.

The title of WUBOX Veteran winner is awarded on the occasion of the WUBOX show to one male and one female of each of the fawn and brindle color.

Ranking of Intermediate, Open and Champion Classes.

The title of WUBOX Winner is awarded on the occasion of the WUBOX show to one male and one female of each of the fawn and brindle color, which were "Excellent 1" from intermediate, Open and Champion Classes.

Then WUBOX BEST MALE and WUBOX BEST FEMALE

(Working Winner and WUBOX Winner).

Finally in the final are called:

BIS JUNIOR from saturday

BEST VETERAN MALE

BEST VETERAN FEMALE

BEST MALE

BEST FEMALE

to nominate the BEST IN SHOW (BOB) and the BEST OF OPPOSED SEX (BOS).

COMPLAINTS

Any complaint based on these present rules, with the exception of those concerning judgments (given that they are without appeal), must be made in writing on the day of the exhibition and be accompanied by a deposit of € 200, which will remain with the organisation if after examination it is recognized without foundation.

All cases not provided for these regulations and disputes relating to its interpretation will be judged immediately by the organizing committee and may object of an appeal in writing (registered letter) to the board of WUBOX within 8 days. he decision of the WUBOX Board of Directors is final and irrevocable.

CANCELLATION

If it is impossible to open the exhibition for reasons major events beyond the control of the organizers, the entry fees will not be refunded, as the organizing company will have to cover the organization costs that she engaged.

RESPONSIBILITY

The welfare and health of the dogs must come first. The exhibitors are responsible for the welfare of the dogs. He is it is forbidden to expose a dog to a situation that could be dangerous to his health and well-being, such as example leaving it in the car in excessively hot or cold and/or treat him cruelly. The violation of this rule will lead to the exclusion from the dog show in Classes.

Anyone who knowingly gives false information, makes changes or interventions on his dog or tolerates it, likely to deceive the judge will be excluded from the test. Ranking, titles and prizes awarded during the exhibition may be revoked. In case of repeat offence, a temporary or permanent ban of exposure may be pronounced by the Board. administration of the WUBOX.

The organizing company declines all responsibility for the leader theft, loss, flight, illness, death of exposed animals, bite caused by them, etc. and that in some case or for whatever reason. Dangerous dogs will not be admitted. Exhibitors are solely responsible within the exhibition area of accidents and other damage caused by their dogs, both to third parties and to themselves, the organisation can in no case be held responsible in their place. By the mere fact of the commitment of their dogs, the exhibitors accept absolutely, without conditions or reservations, all articles of these regulations which they acknowledge having taken knowledge by committing to the WUBOX show. In all cases not provided for in these regulations, the regulations of the Société Centrale Canine will be applied.

PENALTIES

May be temporarily or permanently excluded from exhibitions and competitions organized by the French Association of Boxer:

- Exhibitors who are guilty of acts against honor,
 - those who have made a false statement,
 - those who have had their dog undergo any operation likely to mislead about its quality,
 - those who, by their language, their writings, their acts, harm the success of the Exhibition or harm the prestige of the Judges,
 - those who have surreptitiously introduced a dog not engaged, or replaced a dog engaged by another.
- Sanctions will be imposed in accordance with articles 4 and 8 of the Internal Regulations of the French Association of Boxer.

RABIES PROPHYLAXIS

PROPHYLAXIE DE LA RAGE

It is necessary to bring the vaccination card or the European passport.

For the Boxers of foreign exhibitors, the vaccination anti-rabies must have been done for more than one month, the certificate must have been authenticated by the authorities' veterinarians in the country of origin, guarantee that the animal has been vaccinated by a process authorized in that country and be translated officially in French. These same documents must be presented to access at the exhibition. In addition, dogs must be departed health. The origins of each of them should be able to be justified at all times. The designated official veterinarian by the Administration may refuse admission of dogs to the Exposure in the event of non-compliance with the conditions sanitary.

CONFIRMATION (Mostly for French dogs)

Confirmation age: 12 months minimum.

The confirmations will be made at the end of the judgments. Alone French judges can ensure confirmation. Your dog must be clearly identified and you must present with his identification sheet and his certificate of birth of the Société Centrale Canine, or emanating from a country member of the FCI or recognized by the FCI, as well as the correctly completed confirmatory examination form.

The sale of puppies is prohibited within the perimeter of the exhibition!

CAUTION won't be able to compete: Boxers with cropped ears. Tailed boxers naturally short or bobbed-tailed born.
